

THE PROBLEM: Political attacks on your First Amendment rights

- Citizens cannot improve government policies.
- Voter information is controlled by political insiders.
- Legislators call **35,000+ bills** “emergencies” to stop petitions.
- Complex 1563-word procedures from 1910 are run by lawyers.

Politicians hate petitions. We share legislative power, but they tell us to shut up and obey. They stop our petitioning for a vote.

THE SOLUTION: The Petition Rights Amendment (PRA)

- Permit local petitions. Ballot titles up to 60 words must be in plain English.
- Citizens file facts for voter guides. We hold one election yearly.
- Limit state to 12 “emergencies” yearly. Fewer lawsuits, faster review.
- 366 simple words in law let average citizens request a vote.

Proposed ballot title in 2026:

“Shall Colorado allow petitions to all local governments; review draft petitions quicker; inform voters of petition contents; limit ballot titles to 60 words; cap new laws exempt from possible petitions; hold petition elections yearly; change most petitions only by another petition; prohibit petition fees or fines; and repeal certain petition laws?”
